#### Planning for vegetarian diets.

Did you know there are different types of vegetarians?

- Vegans do not eat the flesh of any animal or any animal product eg cheese.
- ❖ Lacto-vegetarians do not eat the flesh of any animal but they will eat eggs, milk, cheese, honey etc.
- Demi- or semi vegetarians often choose to eat a mainly vegetarian diet because they don't eat red meat. They sometimes eat poultry and fish and eggs, milk and cheese.

#### Ingredients use in vegetarian foods

Textured vegetable protein, TVP is used in vegetarian shepherd's pie to provide the main source of protein

Quorn

Myco-protein is used in fillets to provide a 'chicken like' texture.

Tofu (made from soya beans) absorbs flavours, so is used as a meat alternative in stir-fries.
